Room	Rug Size	Best For	Notes
Living Room	12'x15'	Large open layouts	All furniture sits fully on the rug
	9'x12'	Standard living rooms	Creates a balanced, formal look
	8'x10'	Medium rooms	Place only front legs of sofas/chairs
	5'x8'	Small rooms/apartments	Makes compact spaces feel bigger
Bedroom	9'x12'	King beds	Extends beyond nightstands for luxury
	8'x10'	Queen beds	Extends 18–24 inches on each side
	6'x9'	Full beds	Balanced comfort and aesthetics
	5'x7'	Twin beds	Compact yet cozy layout
	2'6"x8'	Runner rugs	Great for small bedrooms with twin beds
Dining Room	9'x12'	8–10 chairs	Perfect for large gatherings
	8'x10'	6–8 chairs	Most common family dining setup
	6'x9'	4–6 chairs	Ideal for cozy family dinners
Kitchen	2'6"x8'	Runners	Along sinks or galley kitchens
	3'x5' / 4'x6'	Small rugs	In front of sinks or prep areas
